GENERAL INFORMATION

FYAP posters should be **submitted via email** by the deadline stated above to the CRC Program Manager at gadkison@fsu.edu.

You are not required to print your poster; the CRC will provide a printed copy of your poster that you may take with you after the poster session.

The poster session will not be a formal presentation, but rather a reception-type format to encourage conversation and interaction among the 2022-2023 FYAP cohort as well as the incoming Assistant Professors in attendance.

Recognition will be given for 'best poster(s)' based on the requirements stated below.

POSTER REQUIREMENTS

Finished poster must be 24" wide by 36" tall (vertical format); **no exceptions**. Feel free to be creative with the fonts, charts, layout, etc., though!

Your poster should address the following questions (derived from the *Heilmeier Catechism*):

- What are you trying to do with your work? Be sure to articulate objectives with jargon-free language.
- What are the limits of the current practice/how is it currently done?
- What is new in your approach, and why do you think it will be successful?
- If you are successful, what difference will it make in your field?
- What are the risks?
- Along these lines, how much have you been able to accomplish with the FYAP award?
- Where does your work go from here? What are the next steps?

Be sure to include your name, department, and contact information on the poster, and please indicate (by email or through the registration form) whether or not we may upload your poster to the CRC website.
