DEVELOPING SCHOLAR AWARD (DSA)

DISTINGUISHED RESEARCH PROFESSOR (DRP) AWARD

Designed to recognize and honor outstanding research, scholarly, and/or creative activities among faculty with national and international visibility at the rank of full Professor.

DEVELOPING SPECIALIZED FACULTY (DSF) AWARD

Designed to recognize successful specialized faculty members several years into their careers and identify and honor future research/scholar/scientist leaders.

DISTINGUISHED UNIVERSITY SCHOLAR (DUS) AWARD

Designed to recognize and honor outstanding research and/or creative activities among eligible specialized faculty at senior levels of their position.


