

Strengthening school experiences for refugee young people, families, and their teachers in Tallahassee

- ***Motivating understanding:***
Refugee students in TLH are facing significant bullying and othering in schools.
- ***Emerging findings:***
Refugee students in TLH schools are struggling to develop language & literacy skills in English. This challenge undermines relationship-building & academic skills.
- Teachers need additional support to meet students' varied needs.



Next steps:

- Begin interviews with additional refugee families from Venezuela & Afghanistan
- Hold arts-based events with refugee youth in Tallahassee
- Undertake data analysis, academic writing and grant submissions to share & deepen the work.
